Course program:

This course covers the details of using (BGP) routing with IPv6. The format of the course is to explain theory and practice, and then to show working configurations and protocol interactions in a test network. Participants who bring a laptop with an IPv6-capable operating system (Windows, MacOS, Linux, FreeBSD) will be able to configure IPv6 on their own system and see how this interacts with the test network.
